**An Ordinance Adopting Hiring Standards
for Part-Time Police Officers in the
City of Colona, Illinois County of Henry**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Colona, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted a revision to the Illinois Municipal Code requiring that municipalities employing part-time police officers shall, by ordinance, establish hiring standards for part-time police officers and shall submit those standards to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 65, Section 5/3.1-30-21, ordains to adopt hiring standards for part-time police officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Colona, Illinois, wishes to maintain compliance with the Illinois statutory mandate as aforesaid;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Colona, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: POLICE OFFICERS

1. That all police officers, other than those officers who shall be employed on a full-time basis, shall be qualified to enter and successfully complete any training mandated by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board.
2. That the aforesaid hiring standard, particularly with respect to part-time police officers employed by the City of Colona, Illinois, shall be submitted to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board, as required by statute.

SECTION TWO: GENERAL PROVISIONS


REPEALER: All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.


SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
