

Paper- Acceptable paper products would include: Magazines, junk mail, copy paper, envelopes, newspaper, shredded paper, books hard or soft bound. Paper can also be bagged to keep it dry or tied with string. **NO PAPER PLATES**

Cardboard- Corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes, beverage containers, packing and shipping boxes, paper egg cartons, soap containers, shoeboxes, and Kleenex boxes.

- **NO waxed cardboard** – such as milk containers, juice boxes,
- **Please remove any packing peanuts or Styrofoam from the boxes.**

Miscellaneous Metals - Such as coat hangers, bicycles, pots, pans, lawn chairs.

Cans- Aluminum, tin, or bi-metal cans are all accepted. Labels due not have to be removed. Aerosol cans are accepted also.



Plastics – Look for the following symbol on the bottles

We accepted this symbol with the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7.



#1 Plastics (PET) – such as water bottles or soda bottles clear plastic

#2 Plastics (HDPE) - such as milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, cloudy or dark colored plastic.

#3, #4, # 5 and #7 Plastics– plastic packaging, food containers

We **DO NOT** accept:

- *#6 plastic – Which is Styrofoam.
- * Plastic bags or Zip lock, or bread bags

_ * NO GLASS

*No Insulin Needles (place needles in plastic container and dispose of in garbage)

* No paper plates
